

Behaviour for Learning System during school closure

Students working from home presents different challenges to when they are in school. Some parts of the current B4L system have been amended to enable clear communication with parents regarding the progress their child is making in the work we are setting.

Events are usually issued for lack of work or effort with classwork or home learning. These carry detentions in some form which with school closed, cannot be served. We cannot extrapolate the Event from the detention, so we are going to have a new code with amended messages for staff to use to raise awareness to parents / carers that work is not being completed or completed to the required standard. These are prefixed by the letter W.

Students will still be rewarded for good work or positive contributions through the awarding of house points. These will continue to count towards form and house totals. Updated descriptions can be found below.

Positive Events

	Positive Points	Name	School closure examples
H1	1	Positive	Classwork / Home learning completed above the standard expected for a student
H2	2	Good	An individual excellent piece of work compared to the students individual ability
H3	3	Very good	Consistently excellent work produced above the expected level of the student. Every teacher should nominate a student of the week from all the students they teach. There is no need to nominate a department one. Tutors should also nominate, for a student who has engaged in the tutor / pastoral activities set.
H4	4	Excellent	At the end of each month, starting in April, each teacher will nominate their student of the month, from the students they teach.
H5	5	Exceptional or Headmaster's Commendation	Where colleagues become aware of an exceptional act of kindness / generosity shown by a student or exceptional performance above and beyond expectations they should send the student name, form and description to Kelly Bonass.



Negative Events

	Name		School closure examples
W1	Warning	Log on Bromcom	Classwork / Home learning not completed at the standard expected for a student
W2	Repeated Warning	Log on Bromcom	An individual has repeatedly not completed school work or to the expected standard
W3	Progress Plateaux	Log on Bromcom and email parent / carer with description of concern.	Consistently lack of work produced at the expected level of the student.
W4	Progress Stalled	Log on Bomcom. Raise with HOD / HOF to communicate with parents / carers.	Very little or no work produced over an extended period of lessons.
W5	Progress Concaving Downward	Log on Bomcom. HOF / HOD to raise with HOY / PDs for intervention	Consistently producing no work despite previous steps / actions to address the concern.
