

Reopening March 2021

Information for Year 12 &13 students and parents / carers

- It is essential that all students follow social distancing expectations in school as well as on their journey to and from Verulam. This includes being 2 metres away from staff
- Students must wear facemasks in all indoor spaces unless they are medically exempt. Masks may be removed for some practical lessons like PE and the teacher will instruct them to do this
- Enter via Jennings Road only and walk when on school site. Bike park by Sixth Form
- Gather in the Sixth Form foyer or grass area outside Sixth Form (See attached map)
- Sixth Form formal dress code applies
- PE in block E will not take place until Easter
- If students are taking part in an extra-curricular club, they should bring trainers / kit in a bag
- Students must bring their own small bottle of hand sanitising gel
- If using Greenwood Bus, sit in year bubbles with Y7 at the front, followed by Y8 etc. Public transport rules apply so face covering must be worn at all times whilst on the bus
- Try to avoid public transport and walk / cycle where possible
- If using public transport students must wear a face covering

School Day

- Students must attend form time on they days they have a lesson P1. Otherwise, they only come into school for lessons or for testing purposes
- They may leave the site when finished for the day (end of P2, P4 or P6) as there is no in school supervised 'study' during P1, P2, P5 and P6.
- Rooms will be allocated for independent study during P3 & 4. Please check the screen in Sixth Form Cafe for daily updates
- We will continue with the current arrangement of not allowing students to go out at lunchtime if they still have timetabled lessons in the afternoon.
- Students will either need to bring in their own lunch or buy lunch from the Sixth Form Café. Face coverings need to be worn when inside the cafe only to be removed when eating/drinking.
- When moving around school there will be a strict one-way system in operation. To help with the flow of students, they should KEEP RIGHT in corridors. Please see attached map.
- This may not be the shortest route between lessons
- Students must follow this at all times except when the fire bell sounds. Here they should vacate the building by the closest exit and walk around the school to their fire assembly point.
- Mr Base (HOY) will be located in the HOY office in the Sixth Form Centre
- Students should not to mix with other students outside of the Sixth Form bubble

If a student feels unwell during the school day, they must see Matron immediately
Students must not attend school if they display any symptoms of Covid-19 or are unwell in any other way.

Absence must be reported in the usual way.
