Trial Exams 1	Assessment taken in school, exam conditions. GCSE English Literature Paper 1 ('Romeo and Juliet' and 'A Christmas Carol' marked externally by HertsFor Learning experienced examiners who regularly mark for AQA.	December 2020
Internal Assessment 1	Assessment taken in school, exam conditions. GCSE English Literature Paper 2 Section A ('An Inspector Calls'). Marked by English teachers - each teacher marked a range of abilities but NOT their own class students and MS used. These were moderated using a 2 mark tolerance as is used in public exams. Moderated internally.	March 2021
Internal Assessment 2	Assessment taken in school, exam conditions. GCSE English Literature Paper 2 Section B only (Unseen poetry analysis and comparison). Marked by English teachers using the MS. Moderated internally.	April 2021
External Assessment 1	Assessment taken in school, exam conditions. GCSE English Literature Paper 1 'Romeo and Juliet' using material provided by the exam board for external assessments. Relevant tolerance applied during moderation.	May 2021
External Assessment 2	Assessment taken in school, exam conditions. GCSE English Literature Paper 1 'A Christmas Carol' using material provided by the exam board for external assessments. Relevant tolerance applied during moderation.	May 2021
