Start of term – mass testing

When school reopens after the holidays there will be a staggered start to term to support on site LFD testing for all students with parental consent, as required by the DfE under current guidance.

We will be using Thursday 6th and Friday 7th of January 2022 to complete the testing. Students in years **11,12,13** and **7** with parental consent for testing, will come into school on Thursday 6th January to be tested and will then return home. Those who test negative will return to school the following day (**Friday 7**th **January**) as long as their LFD test remains negative, to start lessons according to their timetable.

Years **8**, **9** and **10** students with parental consent for testing, will come into school on Friday 7th January to be tested and will then return home. Those students in years 8, 9 and 10 who test negative will return to school on **Monday 10th January** as long as their LFD test remains negative, to start lessons according to their timetable.

The timings are below. Please ensure your son/daughter attends at the correct time; students will only be able to test in their allocated time slot. The testing will take place in the Sports Hall. All students **must** wear masks on arrival. Any positive test results will be communicated to students and parents.
