Dear Parent/Carer

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your support and patience this term, as the transition of a school under new leadership can be challenging. As we approach the half term break, I'd also like to thank you for your continued support with the Covid-19 measures that we have introduced. As you will be aware, the Covid-19 case rate throughout Hertfordshire remains high especially in younger and unvaccinated age groups leading to several recent outbreaks within school communities. It is therefore essential that as we head into half term, you encourage your child to test regularly. If you need home testing kits to continue testing over half term, you can order more <u>online</u> through gov.uk or collect from your local pharmacy.

By testing your child twice a week, you will help us to reduce transmission of Coronavirus, keep all pupils in school and enable the school to remain open to minimise disruption to their education, to you and to your household.

To date, the Covid measures that we have implemented have significantly reduced the number of infections in school. However, as a result of rising infections both locally and











nationally, we have decided to continue wearing masks in the building at all times; both in communal spaces and in classrooms.

As you will be aware, the NHS has been carrying out Covid-19 vaccinations in schools across the country this term. The schedule date for Covid-19 vaccinations at Verulam School is the 15th November. Please see the attached letter regarding consent for this to be carried out in school.

However, all parents/carers can now also book a vaccine for 12-15 year olds online.
