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Dear Parent/Carer

We have had a really positive start to the spring term. However, like schools across the country, we continue to be affected by Covid-19 and the challenges this poses in terms of staff and pupil absence. I'd like to take this opportunity to thank you, our parents and carers, for your continued support at this difficult time.

Behaviour

Since September we have focused our pastoral programme on how students treat one another. All too often in the modern world, individuals say or do things under the guise of 'banter'. *Someone's banter is someone else's pain* and it is essential that a culture of 'banter' is not accepted. We would appreciate all parents/carers in echoing this core message so that this is consolidated within the home.

Return to school - PE/Games

Half term marks the end of pupils wearing their PE/Games kit on days that they have PE/Games. From Monday 21st February, all boys will be expected to bring their kit to change into at school. With the lifting of Covid restrictions, pupils are able to once again change on site.

Lockers

The dark blue lockers outside of the school canteen are being removed over half term. All pupils that currently occupy one of these lockers have been asked to relocate their belongings to a free locker inside the canteen.

Uniform and Jewellery

The school operates a clear uniform policy. All students Year 7-11 are expected to adhere to the policy, wearing the full school uniform. Please note, trainers are not permitted and any students arriving at school without shoes (without validated medical exemption) will not be permitted to go to lesson. Please ensure that









if your child needs new shoes, that these are purchased over the half term break. Jewellery is prohibited with the exception of one pair of studs.

Hair Policy

As you may be aware from recent reports, we decided to remove any reference to hair from our Behaviour Policy in September 2021. This move is to ensure that no student is unfairly treated or penalised as a result of the way in which their hair naturally grows. We feel that this is a positive non-discriminatory step to support all students in feeling comfortable in their own skin.

Reviews

Since September, as the new Headteacher I have audited the school and reviewed our Behaviour Policy, SEND and Inclusion provision. We'd like to say a huge thank you to all parents, governors, staff and pupils that have been involved in these reviews. The feedback and input of all stakeholders has been incredibly useful. We are now working to plan and implement revised systems ready for September 2022 and will release more details about this in the summer term.

First Aid

We have a new First Aid provision. Should any students feel unwell or be injured they should go to the Main Reception where a first aider will be called.

Masks

It is no longer necessary for pupils to wear masks in communal spaces and classrooms. However, your child may continue to wear a mask if they wish to. Please note, should infections begin to rise next half term, we will review this and reintroduce masks if necessary.
