

## The International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women – 24th November 2022

This day is marked every year around the world and is followed by 16 days of activism; a campaign to end gender-based violence. Orange the World is led by the United Nations to mark awareness of the campaign, which ends on Human Rights Day on 10th December. Buildings and organisations all over the world take part in this campaign every year, by lighting up orange in an act of solidarity for the campaign, and as a public call to action. It is an opportunity to raise awareness at a local, national and international level about violence against women and girls. The pandemic of violence against women is not new. Even before COVID-19 hit us, globally 243 million women and girls were abused by their intimate partners in the previous year. The COVID-19 pandemic intensified the violence, even as support services faltered and it became harder to get help.

At Verulam we will continue our support for St Albans and Hertsmere Women's Refuge in conjunction with Orange the World day. On the 24th November, students are invited to wear one item of ORANGE clothing WITH their school uniform (not football shirts or hoodies). We will be transforming the school hall into 'The Orangery Jazz Lounge' where some of our talented Year 11 jazz musicians will entertain diners during the lunch break. Students can enjoy a different, more relaxing lunch break in the hall, which will be bathed in orange light and orange table decorations, IF they are wearing orange! If your child would like to wear orange on the day we would appreciate a £1 donation – ParentPay donations will open next week.
