Subject Vision: Art & Design - Our aim is for students to develop a love for Art and design. Over the two-year course, students will go on a creative journey which will be led by themselves and supported by their teacher aiding their personal, artistic development. They will have creative freedom to produce what they like so long as it links to their brief and mark scheme. This creative freedom to study artists of their choice will give them more opportunities to explore art that truly inspires and motivates them. They are encouraged to reflect upon current affairs and their impact on the visual art scene which can encompass a multitude of topics which ultimately allow for cross curricular learning. Students are encouraged to keep open minded with their exploration of artists with directed research into a broad range of artists which include those from different cultural, racial, political, sexual orientation and with disabilities, educating them to see how visual art is a universal language which bears no prejudices and allows for inclusivity by those who produce it and what it is based upon. Beyond the classroom pupils are encouraged to enter competitions building their confidence as aspiring artists. This often results in celebrating their achievements through public displays, giving them a greater sense of achievement. Trips are regularly organized to Art galleries showing historical and contemporary artworks, as well as opportunities to speak with artists which inspires them and helps them to understand how to reach a career in the arts.
