# **Site Improvements**

This Summer break, the last of the student toilets will start to be renovated. The toilets in the Bradshaw building will be transformed in a similar style to those that were installed last year across the site.











In addition, we are investing in some outdoor gym equipment (pictured right) outside the sports' hall, new table tennis tables, additional recycled plastic benches and four new goals, to improve the recreational spaces further.

# Safeguarding

In November 2022, we were visited by Ofsted to review our safeguarding practice. The Inspector found safeguarding at Verulam to be **effective**. However, as a school, we are continuously looking at our systems to reflect and review what we do, so that they stay relevant and keep our children safe. After the shocking recent events reported by the National Press at Tewkesbury Academy, we send our love and best wishes to Headteacher, Kathleen and her staff team. By all accounts their calm professionalism in the face of understandable fear and confusion was simply remarkable. The staff there had to deal with a serious situation forcing them to instigate lockdown procedures. All schools have lockdown procedures, and thankfully having to instigate them is incredibly rare in this country. However, effective safeguarding means having an attitude that "it could happen here". In the final week of term, we will be practising our lockdown procedure so that our staff and students are clear on what they would need to do in order to keep themselves and others safe, should such an incident occur.

### Uniform

Last year, I informed you that the Government published statutory guidance to make school uniform costs affordable for all, after a legal requirement to do so passed into law. As of September 2023, Beat and Stevensons will be selling significantly less branded items as part of our uniform. Full details of the uniform can be found here.

### **Assessment and Chromebooks**









At the start of the next academic year, we will be launching a new Assessment system – <u>DPR (Dynamic Progress Reporting)</u>. This will make the curriculum in every subject on your child's timetable explicit to both them, and to you as a parent/carer and will significantly improve the academic report that you receive detailing your child's progress.

DPR is an award-winning assessment reporting platform and will be launched for each year group in line with their calendared **Information Evening** in the Autumn term. In addition, each year group's parents/carers will be offered an optional technical support evening.
