We are pleased to have welcomed all students back to school this term. Staff and students returned from the Summer to fantastic A Level and GCSE results. We are immensely proud of our school community and its progress to date.

## **Site Improvements**


Over the break, a number of renovations have taken place, most notably, at Sandpit Lane. We have invested a considerable amount to re-tarmac and re-fence the drive and parking areas, whilst also improving site security there.





In addition, as a result of our partnership with St Albans City FC whereby we are facilitating their Education Programme as part of our extended Sixth Form offer, we have been able to invest in improving the shower facilities for our students at Sandpit Lane.

The toilets in the Bradshaw block have also been renovated in line with the other toilets that were updated last year. Outside, a number of new benches and table tennis tables have also been installed.

Lastly, the outdoor multi-rig has been installed thanks to the fundraising efforts of our PTFA (Parent Teacher and Friends Association). Our students have been enjoying challenging themselves on this equipment whilst burning off some energy!

Later this term, a new lighting rig is set to be installed in the main hall, to aid dramatic performances and other events held at the school. This is a costly development and one that was essential as a result of the previous rig no longer being fit for purpose.

Improving the site and facilities is an ongoing task, especially with a site that has some buildings that date back to the 1930s. As you are probably aware from reports in the media and the union strikes that interrupted school life last year, school budgets are incredibly strained because of a lack of government funding. All schools are facing increasing budget constraints and challenges as a result.

## **Assistance Required!**

As a result, we need your assistance to support some improvements that are long overdue and that we simply cannot afford to address on our own. The chairs in our main hall are incredibly old, having well exceeded their shelf life.

We would like to replace the 350 chairs this academic year, so that students, staff and parents can sit more comfortably in assemblies, talks, performances etc.

# Parents' Evenings

During Covid, most schools moved to online Parents' Evenings. Although there are many benefits to online appointments, we also recognise the importance of having face-to-face communications. As a result, this year we will trial a hybrid version — with Parents' Evenings being face to face until 5:50 p.m. and online appointments running from 6:15 p.m. This will allow parents to select their preference. All parents will be required to be off-site by 6 p.m. to allow staff to conduct their online appointments.









Unfortunately, there are always some staff who teach two or more classes in a Year group which limits the number of appointments that they can accommodate. For any parent/carers not able to access an appointment, an appointment for a phone call regarding your child's progress will be scheduled.

## **DPR (Dynamic Progress Reporting)**

As detailed at the end of the last academic year, we will be using DPR to set homework and to provide live feedback regarding your child's progress. Information will be shared at each Year Group Information Evening and there is an optional DPR support session available to each Year Group.

Mr Zaman, Assistant Headteacher, will contact you directly via ParentMail with information regarding DPR, as well as links to Loom videos to support you and your child using this platform. We will continue to use Google Classroom to store resources and to communicate with students, however, all homework will be set on DPR once your child's Year Group has had their Information Evening.

#### **School Dinners**

Our current menus are available <u>here</u>. Please note that the cost of the meal deal has increased to £2.75. We provide free jugs of water on each table during break and lunch, as well as hydration stations and two water bottle stations for refills. We recommend that you purchase a reusable water bottle for your child, so that they can stay hydrated at no cost whilst at school.

### **Free School Meals**

Your child could get a free school meal if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you don't get more than £16,190 a year)









- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit (with annual earned income of no more than £7,400 after tax and not including any benefits you get).

Applications to receive or check eligibility for free school meals is managed through Hertfordshire County Council. The online application takes 5 mins and, in most cases, can tell you straight away if your child can get free meals at school. Click <a href="here">here</a> for further information.
