## AIMS OF THE COURSE

#### The aims of the course are to:

Equivalent to half of an A Level. Enables you to develop independent research skills, project management, organisation and presentation skills.

## WHAT WILL YOU STUDY?

You work with 'supervisor' guidance to plan, research and produce an independent project of your choice.

You will study research methods, time-management, project organisation, essay writing, referencing and presentation skills.

The course enables you to develop a 5000 word essay; or an artefact and 2000 word essay.

## WHAT WIDER SKILLS WILL YOU DEVELOP?

You will develop independent research skills, planning and organisation strategies, presentation skills, academic referencing and self-evaluation qualities.
