SPOTLIGHT ON YEAR 8

Following the theme of "Equality, Diversity and Inclusion", our students experienced sessions on Hate Crime, Digital Citizenship, Foreign Food tasting, slam poetry and virtual field trips.

In November, 51 students enjoyed an overnight trip to Stratford-upon-Avon to visit Shakespeare's birthplace and saw "The Box of Delights" at the Royal Shakespeare Theatre. For our next CE Day we are planning a visit to KidZania, London, with role-play activities designed to mirror real-world careers.

In May we also have our Year 8 trip to Dorset in a tented village near Corfe Castle packed full of activities like paddle boarding, kayaking, coasteering, mud run, beach sports and much more.

Other notable achievements from Year 8 so far this year, proving that Year 8 are taking every opportunity they can are: Zach in 8C becoming the school's Extreme reader at the top of Vesuvius; many successes from our football teams including a 2-1 win against Bonaventures and a 7-2 win against Monks Walk being the most notable matches. Y8 rugby won 4 matches and drew 1 in the Hertfordshire Rugby League Championship. The Table Tennis team went through to the County tournament after beating St Albans Boys in the semi final and drew 2-2 with Kings School in Harpenden. Noah in 8H had an amazing summer of tennis representing the Hertfordshire Under 14s against 47 other countries making it to the last 16 boys, the only 12 year old to ever make it this far!
