The department aims to focus upon the individual, encouraging each student to gain confidence in their abilities and learn that there are many approaches to Art & Design rather than one right way. We encourage a broad approach to developing an appreciation and understanding of contemporary and historical artistic achievements across a range of cultures and contexts. The results of this can be seen around the school in the vibrancy and variety of outcomes. At key stage 4, trips are regularly organized to Art galleries showing historical and contemporary art and the department also enjoys visits for drawing opportunities such as Kew Gardens in the summer.
