Subject Vision: The purpose of the KS3 Spanish Curriculum at Verulam School is to ensure that students develop their ability to communicate confidently and coherently with native Spanish speakers in speech and writing, getting their messages across with increasing accuracy, spontaneity and fluency. They will develop their understanding of how language works, and extend their vocabulary so that they can express themselves in a wide range of contexts whilst following an engaging and culturally enriching curriculum plan that incorporates the different skills required for mastery of a Modern Foreign Language: Speaking; Listening; Reading and Writing. Students will study different topic areas as well as authentic TL literature and media to enhance their cultural awareness.
